**NOTICE of MANDATORY QUARANTINE FOR CERTAIN PEOPLE TRAVELING TO
OKLAHOMA FROM ANOTHER STATE**

as required by

**EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-13, issued April 8, 2020, by The Honorable Kevin Stitt,
Governor of the State of Oklahoma**

Dear Guest,

On April 8, 2020, Governor Stitt issued Executive Order 2020-13, which is effective until May 9, 2020. All persons entering the State of Oklahoma are subject to the Executive Order. The relevant language regarding out-of-state visitors from the Executive Order is set forth below:

I [Governor Stitt] hereby direct all persons who enter the State of Oklahoma from an area with substantial community spread, including but not limited to the New York Tri-State Area (Connecticut, New Jersey and New York), the State of Washington, California, and Louisiana, to quarantine for a period of 14 days from the time of entry into the State of Oklahoma or the duration of the person's presence in the State of Oklahoma, whichever is shorter....This Order shall take effect immediately and apply retroactively to all persons who have entered Oklahoma after being in any area with substantial community spread within the previous 14 days. All persons quarantining under this Section shall be responsible for all costs associated with their quarantine, including transportation, lodging, food, medical care and any other expenses to sustain the person during the period of quarantine.


I hereby direct all persons covered under [the above] paragraph...of this Order to inform any individual in Oklahoma with whom they have had direct physical contact in the past 21 days that they traveled from an area with substantial community spread.

Due to the restrictions, we understand if you would like to cancel your reservation or reschedule for dates outside of the Executive Order. If you choose to cancel or reschedule, please contact the location of your reservation and you will be provided with a full refund or a reschedule at no charge

If you choose to continue on with your reservation and you are traveling from an applicable location please note you will be subject to the following conditions:

- You and anyone you are traveling with must quarantine and not interact with members of the public or park staff for the first 14 days you are in Oklahoma;
- You may not use public park bathrooms or enter any park structure at any time for the first 14 days you are in Oklahoma;

- You may not engage in business with our concessionaires or vendors within the park, which includes marinas, rentals, stores, or any other business on park property for the first 14 days you are in Oklahoma.
- If you have a Recreational Vehicle and need to empty your waste tank, you must call the park office and arrange for a scheduled time so that park staff is able to immediately sanitize the dump station; and
- You must inform all persons with whom you have contact with that you are from an area with substantial community spread for 21 days following the day you entered Oklahoma; and
- After completion of the 14 day quarantine, all persons in Oklahoma are encouraged to follow the CDC guidelines of social distancing at 6 or more feet from others and no gathering in groups of 10 or more people.




FAILURE TO ADHERE TO ANY OF THE ABOVE RESTRICTIONS MAY SUBJECT YOU TO IMMEDIATE EJECTION AND BANNING FROM ALL STATE PARKS IN OKLAHOMA FOR NOT LESS THAN 7 DAYS. IN THE EVENT YOU ARE EJECTED, YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FULL AMOUNT DUE FOR YOUR ENTIRE RESERVATION AND NO REFUND WILL BE ISSUED.

ALL RESERVATIONS, INCLUDING THOSE FOR OTHER PARK PROPERTIES, MADE FOR ANY PERIOD FOR WHICH YOU HAVE BEEN EJECTED SHALL BE CANCELLED AND NO REFUND WILL BE ISSUED FOR ANY AMOUNT PAID.

Please understand that we are striving to keep our parks open to our guests, but the health and safety of both our guests and employees while continuing operations is of critical importance to the Department.
