Escape the sprawl of city life and retreat to the sanctuary of panoramic canyons, gypsum rock cliffs, towering cedars and wild blue sage at Roman Nose State Park.

Built by the Civilian Conservation Corps in 1937, Roman Nose is one of seven original Oklahoma State Parks. Historically a winter campground of the Cheyenne Tribe, it is renowned for its challenging 18-hole canyon golf course, crystal-clear natural springs, rock swimming pool and abundant recreational activities.

Whether you're planning a corporate meeting, leadership retreat or family reunion, Roman Nose State Park offers a tranquil escape from everyday life. With a beautifully renovated 22-room lodge, designed to reflect and pay homage to the natural landscape of the area, reconnect with nature while relaxing in the luxury of modern amenities.

Keeping true to the original mid-century design while honoring the rich history of the park and its Native American heritage, the newly remodeled rooms feature modern design details throughout: plush mattresses, organic bedding, flat-screen LCD televisions, refrigerators and eco-friendly spa products.

Prefer to commune directly with nature? Roman Nose State Park also features 11 rustic cabins, as well as teepee rentals and scenic RV campgrounds and tent sites for an outdoor adventure you won't find anywhere else. Enjoy!
