Roman Nose State Park Lodge Three-Day Itinerary

For a city stay, consider Enid as your hub

Day 1

Arrive at Roman Nose State Park to check in and unpack. Lunch will be served at the lodge restaurant. After lunch, take a drive down historic Route 66 from Highway 281. Continue on to the Stafford Air and **Space Museum** in Weatherford. Thomas Stafford, an Oklahoma native, is a highly decorated NASA astronaut. He was the Commander of Apollo 10 and the first to fly a lunar module in orbit of the Moon. He helped pave the way for the Apollo 11 mission that landed on the moon. Stafford was also part of the Apollo-Soyuz Test Project that eased the tensions between the US and Russia. The museum houses over 3,000 artifacts including space suits, full-sized rockets and much more. Keep driving east on the Mother Road to the Oklahoma Route 66 **Museum** in Clinton, OK. Experience the story of Route 66 from the beginning of the road to the end of the road. After visiting the museum, head back to Weatherford for dinner at Lucille's Roadhouse. Lucille's Roadhouse is a diner inspired by Lucille's service station in Hydro. Enjoy the nostalgic feel of this Route 66 diner and maybe a little chicken fried steak, too. Head back to the lodge for a relaxing night at Roman Nose State Park.

Day 2

For today's Western experience be sure to wear your best cowboy attire. Enjoy breakfast at the lodge restaurant. Choose a traditional breakfast or build your own omelet. After breakfast, take an hour's drive north to Enid, Oklahoma. There, you will meet with reenactors in downtown Enid who will take you back in time and tell you about Enid's fascinating history. They will tell the story of the Land Run of 1893, the largest in US history. You will also hear about the Chisholm Trail, oil booms, and the Great Depression. There is also an urban legend that John Wilkes Booth escaped capture after assassinating President Abraham Lincoln and lived in Enid for years before finally doing himself in. Depart the walking tour for Simpson's Old Time Museum &

Skeleton Creek Productions. Lunch will be served in the saloon. The museum boasts a wide range of Western artifacts as well as several Western working movie sets used by Skeleton Creek Productions. After exploring the museum, your group will star in your very own Western! Members of the Skeleton Creek crew will direct and produce your movie. Your group will receive a final edited copy of your film. Depart Enid and head for Woodward, Oklahoma. You will visit Covingtons **Customs**, a custom motorcycle builder, and get a behind the scenes tour. Covingtons was started in 1993 and has become a world leader in creating high quality custom motorcycles. Next, you will visit the **Plains** Indians & Pioneers Museum. This museum tells the story of Woodward from the early Native Americans that lived in the area and into the modern day. The rotunda features fantastic murals painted by Paul Laune and Pat "Kemoha" Paterson. Among Laune's more famous works, were illustrations for the Hardy Boys Mystery Series. After exploring the museum, you will eat at one of Woodward's favorite eateries. JB's Steakhouse is a good option if you are in the mood for a juicy steak or Diarti for some great Italian options.

Day 3

Depart Roman Nose for Historic Fort Reno Visitor
Center and Museum. You will tour the grounds and learn the importance of this old historic fort in El Reno, Oklahoma. Located at Fort Reno is the US Cavalry
Museum and Research Facility. The museum is located in the old commanding officer's building that has been refurbished and saved from demolition. You will hear stories of brave men, women and horses that have served the country. Continue east on I-40 to Oklahoma City to visit the National Cowboy & Western Heritage Museum. This museum is America's premier institution for Western history and exhibits world renowned collections of western art and artifacts. Enjoy lunch at the Museum Grill.
