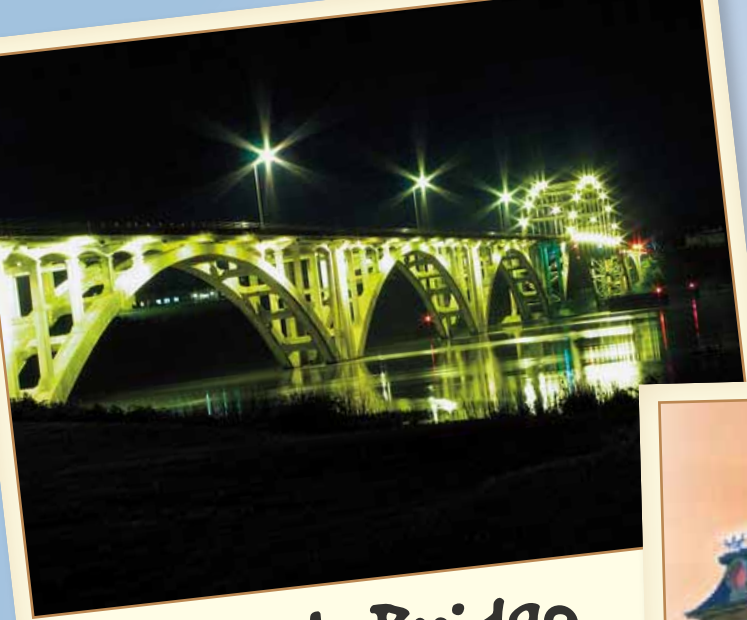

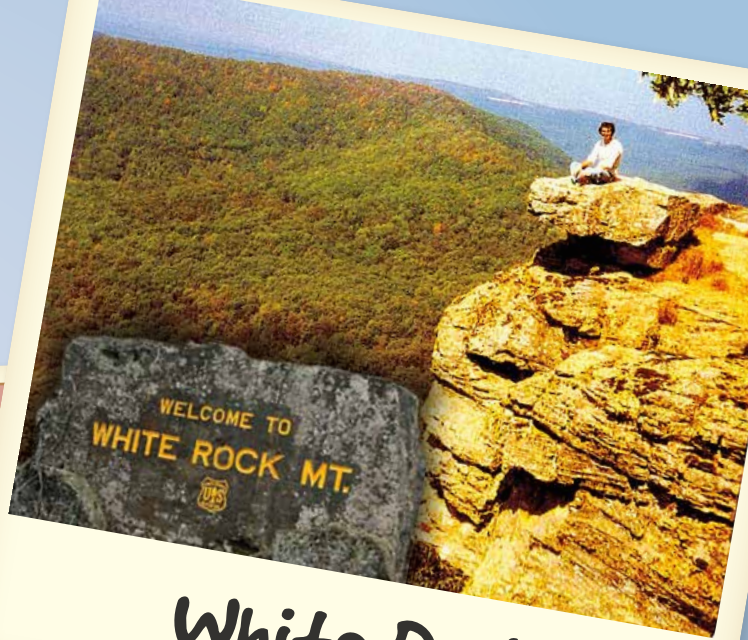
**Ozark Bridge**

Spanning the Arkansas River as Scenic Hwy. 23, this structure is listed as one of the 16 most beautiful long spans in the U.S. by the American Institute of Steel Construction. A lighting project showcases the structure at night.

The former Miss Laura's Social Club, a house of prostitution, serves as a unique visitor center for Fort Smith and is a reminder of the town's rich history. Located at 123 First Street, it is the only bordello listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

One of the highest points in the Ozarks, the mountain takes its name from the sheer cliffs that ring its peak. From a distance, they appear brilliantly white thanks to a unique lichen that grows on the rocky surfaces.

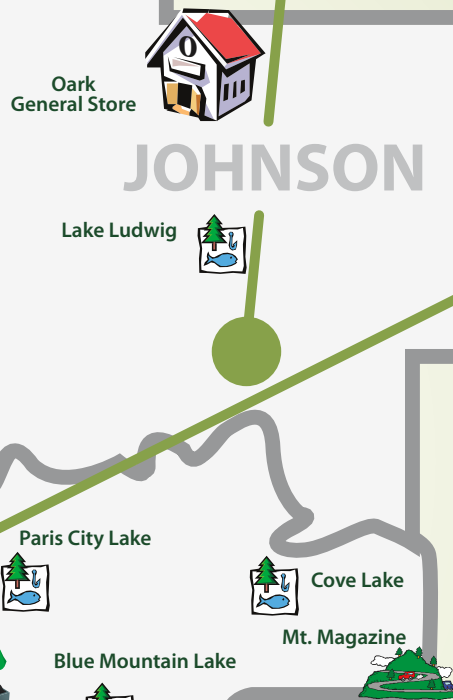
