



## About Woolaroc

**Woolaroc Ranch** is owned and operated by The Frank Phillips Foundation, Inc., a 501c(3) nonprofit organization. The non-refundable registration and all donations are tax deductible according to IRS guidelines. Proceeds will benefit the programs of the **Woolaroc Museum and Wildlife Preserve.**

## Ride Schedule

**Registration and coggins check on arrival.**

**Friday:** Arrival after 3:00 p.m.

Gate closes at 9:00 p.m.

**Saturday:** Arrival and check-in time 7:00 - 9:00 a.m.

**Parking and unloading:** Front gate/elk pen

**Ride begins:** Promptly at 9:30 a.m. (no exceptions)

**Arrive for lunch stop:** 11:45 a.m.

**Lunch and rest period:** 12:00 noon

**Afternoon ride begins:** 1:00 p.m.

**Ride ends:** Approximately 3:30pm

**Dinner:** Approximately 4:00pm

**Woolaroc main grounds close:** 5:00 p.m.

## Suggested Equipment

A camera, weather appropriate clothing, water canteen, rain poncho, sun screen, and insect repellent.

## Rules and Regulations

- Current negative coggins will be checked at gate.
  - Rider under age 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
  - Shoes on your horses are recommended.
  - Riding is prohibited except during the ride.
  - **No riding double or riding bareback.**
  - Kicking horses must be flagged with red on their tail.
  - No stallions.
  - Do not pass trail leaders. Any exceptions could cause confusion to the people behind and endanger riders.
  - No littering, smoking or alcohol permitted.
  - No pets on the trail.
- **\$40.00 Each Rider**
  - **Meals for Non-riders \$10.00 each**
  - **Ride includes** overnight stay on Friday prior to the ride, morning and afternoon guided trail ride and admission to Woolaroc.
  - Lunch & Dinner
  - Riders must provide their own horses and gear.
- Total time in the saddle is approximately 5 hours.

## Meals for Saturday

- Lunches for non-riders by reservation only. (\$10.00 each person)
- Lunch will include a sandwich, a bag of chips & cookie
- Dinner will include smoked meats, potato salad, baked beans and dessert
- Drinks for both meals will include iced tea & water

## Accommodations at Woolaroc

Overnight camping is available on Friday night prior to the ride in an area near the front gate. Be aware that the trail camp is located in a primitive wildlife preserve with roaming buffalo and elk. Port-a-potties will be provided and water is accessible 200 feet from the camp. No electricity is available. For camping on Saturday night there is a \$10.00 fee.
