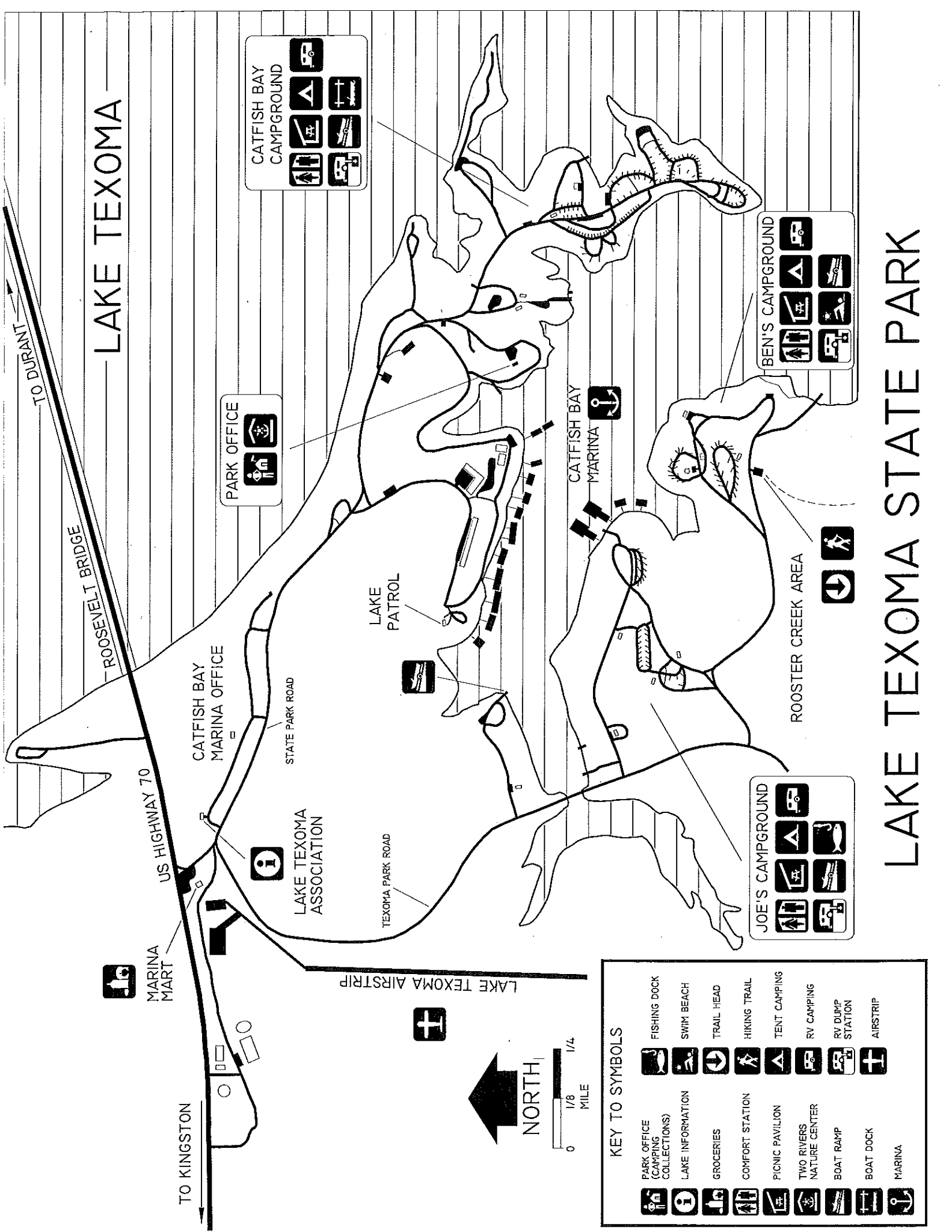

## Lake Texoma State Park / 11500 Park Office Road / Kingston, OK 73439 / 580-564-2566

For the RV Camper: Lake Texoma State Park offers both modern and semi-modern sites for RV Campers. 20 modern sites include water, sewer and electric are in the Catfish Bay area; 40 are in the 400 area, with 28 more in the 500 area. Also available in Catfish Bay are 17 semi-modern sites that offer electricity and water, 9 in the 400 area, and 15 in the 500 area. Some sites have tables and grills. The Rally Area has basic electric and water (no tables or grills in this area) which can accommodate up to 58 campers.

For the Tent Camper: Catfish Bay offers 100 unimproved sites (without utilities), 30 in the 400 area and 20 in the 500 area. Tables and grills are not available at every site. There are six comfort stations (with showers) located throughout the park and three sanitary waste dump stations.

Group Picnic Pavilions: The park has 6 shelters available to accommodate large groups and reunions (50 to 200). Rental fees apply. The Rally pavilion has a small kitchen.

Golf: Chickasaw Pointe, a privately operated golf course, is an extraordinary championship course over 7,000 yards long. Located across the street from the park, the 18-hole par 72 course offers a picturesque view of Lake Texoma. The Pro Shop is complete with a grill and dining area. For tee time reservations contact Chickasaw Pointe at 580-564-2581.

Marina/Fishing/Boating: Catfish Bay Marina gas dock includes a convenience store, snack bar and mixed drinks bar. Overnight slips are available at the gas dock. The marina offers boat sales and repair service. Guide services are also offered through the marina. Gas Dock hours vary seasonally. Six unlighted boat ramps are located throughout the park.

Hiking/Swimming: The Running Deer Trail is a 1.6 mile (round trip) hike. The trail is available for hikers year round and is a popular spot to bring children and families for lessons in nature. Location and entrance point to the trail is near the swim beach. The swim beach is located in the Ben's campground area. There are no lifeguards on duty. No glass containers or dogs allowed on swim beach.

Concessions/Entertainment: Two Rivers Nature Center is located on a hill overlooking the marina and gas dock. Information on park wildlife, animal habitat and plant life can be found at the center. The Marina Mart is located at the entrance to the park and is easily accessible for any last minute or forgotten items.

### Lake Texoma State Park Guidelines

- Pets must be on a leash at all times and must be in the presence of owners or confined within owner's camping unit. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after pets. Pets are not allowed on swimming beach.
- Parking is not allowed on unoccupied campsites. Use only the site you have paid for.
- Do not drive across grass; parking immediately off the roadway is tolerated where parking is limited.
- Payment of site is expected immediately after occupying site.
- Alcohol above 3.2% is prohibited within Oklahoma State Parks.
- Do not disturb wildlife, feeding is discouraged.
- Quiet hours are from 11:00pm until 6:00am and your noise should not impair your neighbor.
- Unlicensed, motorized vehicles are not allowed (four wheelers, golf carts and mini-bikes). Permits may be issued for handicap use of golf carts for approved situations.
- Campfires are camper's responsibility, you must be present while fire is burning and you are responsible for completely exterminating the fire before leaving.
- No Littering! Dumpsters are located throughout the park, please keep all areas free of trash.
- No more than two camping units (1 RV & 1 tent) are allowed on any RV site and only one may be connected to electricity. Additional fees may be charged for the second camping unit on the site. Two RV's on the same site is not allowed. You will be charged for the type of site you occupy, regardless if you use the amenities or not.
- Senior discount (62 & older) – Eligible senior must be present and staying at the campsite in order to receive the discount. Senior will not receive discounts for multiple sites.
- Disability discount (must be 100% disabled). Disabled person must be staying on site & provide proof of disability. T.D. individuals will not receive discounts for multiple sites.

**Storm Information:** Lake Texoma State Park is located in Marshall County. The surrounding counties are Love to the west, Bryan to the east, Johnston to the north and Grayson County, TX to the south. Weather alert radios should be tuned to 162.475. In severe weather, seek shelter in the nearest solid structure.

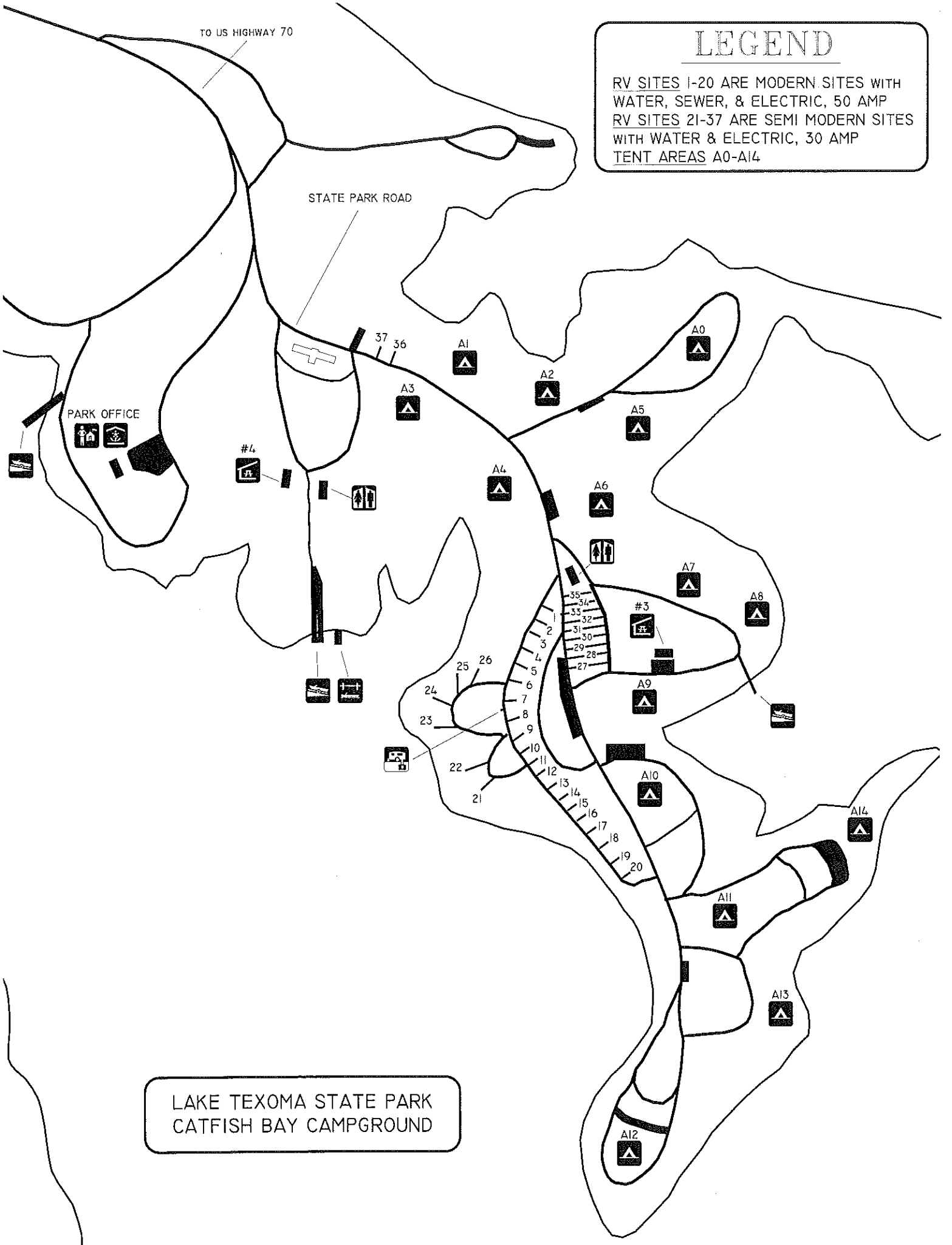

RV SITES 440-448 ARE SEMI MODERN SITES WITH WATER & ELECTRIC, 30 AMP

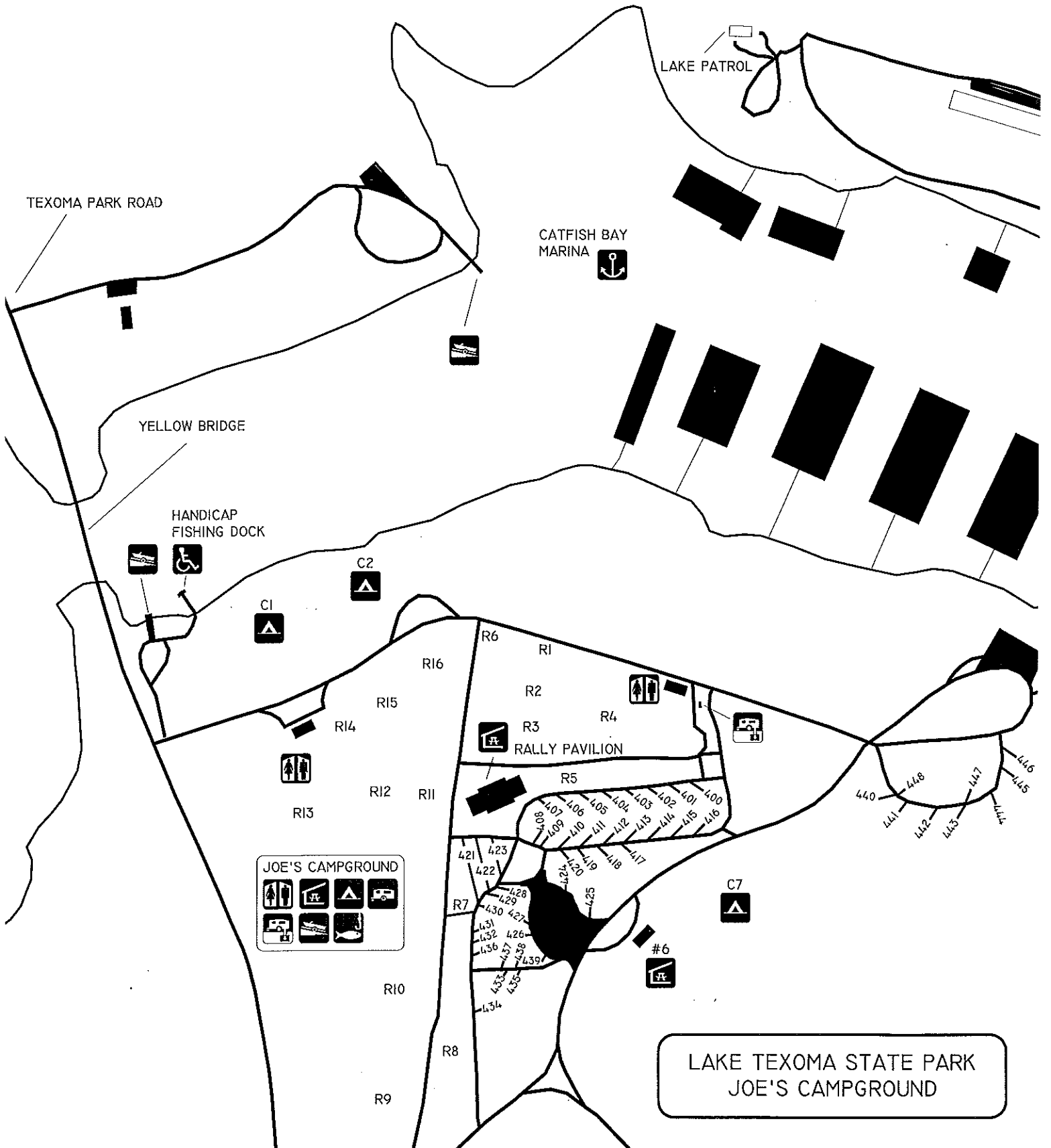
TENT AREAS C1 - C2 - & C7

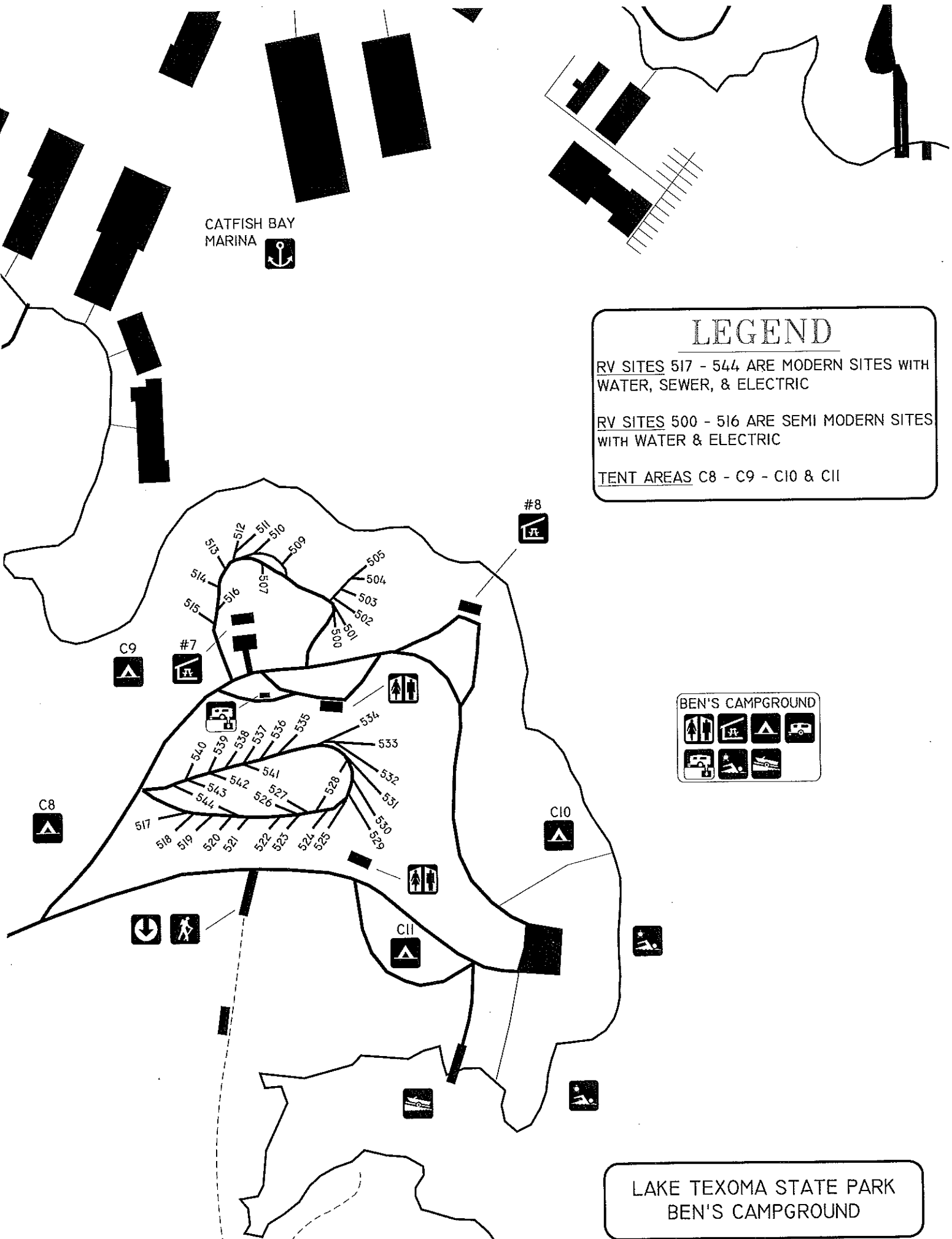
