This "Soddy" was built by Marshal McCully in 1894 and has been restored and preserved as the only existing sod home. McCully took part in the "Run of 93" September 16, 1893, and filed a claim in the Cherokee Outlet. His claim was disputed so he moved to file a new claim on the land where this "soddy" now stands. Today, this house stands as a testament to those hearty souls that settled Oklahoma.
