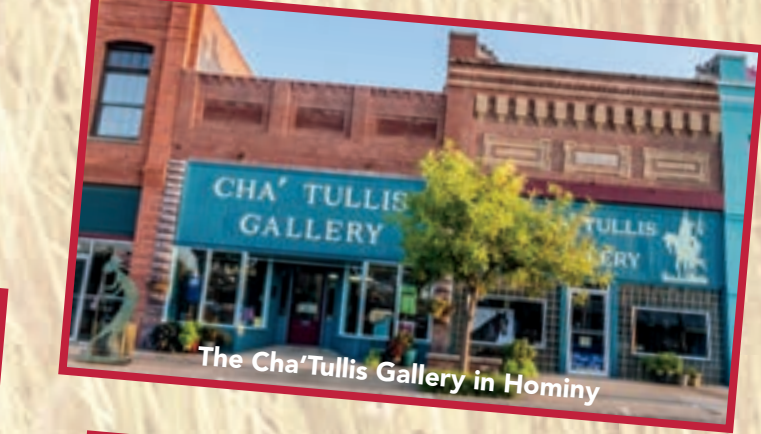
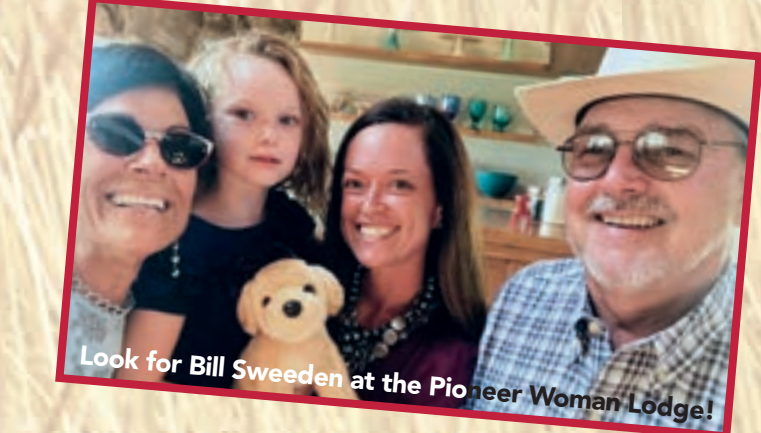

 Founded in 1925 by oil tycoon Frank Phillips, Woolaroc is a 3,700-acre working ranch that has a 50,000 square-foot museum with a collection described by Christie's of New York as "one of the finest collections of Southwest art in the world" along with the original Lodge home and a large herd of bison, elk, longhorn cattle, scotch highland cattle and hundreds of deer. Woolaroc is listed on the National Register of Historic Places, and the museum hosts an outstanding collection of Western art and artifacts, Native American material and one of the finest collections of Colt firearms in the world."
