RULES & REGULATIONS

SBF assumes no responsibility for cancellation of balloon activities due to any reason. SBF is not responsible for loss/damage to vehicles/content including any tent or vehicle. You have agreed to follow these rules and regulations at the time of booking, please keep in mind that we only have these rules in place for your safety. You must comply with all the Camping Rules and Regulations for the safety of everyone. Failure to comply is cause for removal.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

VEHICLES

No golf carts or any other ATVs are allowed for personal use on the Festival Grounds, including the Campgrounds, unless pre-approved.

CAMPFIRES

NO CAMPFIRES OR PROPANE FIREPITS ARE ALLOWED. IF YOU ARE CAUGHT BURNING A CAMPFIRE OF ANY SORT, YOU WILL BE ESCORTED OUT. CITRANELLA CANDLES AND OTHER CANDLES ARE ALLOWED, AS ARE CAMPING LANTERNS.

DRONES

NO DRONES OR ANY OTHER UNAUTHORIZED MOTORIZED FLYING AIRCRAFT ALLOWED.

(FTR is in place during this event) If you are caught you will be escorted off the property after a discussion with the FAA & other Government agencies.

CHECK-IN / CHECK-OUT / PARKING

ARRIVALS / DEPARTURES CHECK-IN CHECK-OUT TIMES

CHECK IN TIME: 6:00am-6:00pm CHECK OUT TIME: 11:00am

LATE ARRIVALS

If you should arrive after 6:00pm to be checked in, you will be allowed to check-in the next morning.

OCCUPANCY

You may have up to FOUR (4) people staying overnight at your camping site. Additional people require additional camping site permits.

RESERVATIONS

There are no reservations for camping spots at the Festival. Sites are designated on a 'first-come first-served' basis.

CAR CAMPING

Camping overnight in a vehicle is allowed, ONLY in the Campgrounds Parking Area with a Camping Permit. This is the only overnight parking allowed at the Festival, other than RV Parking. Please keep your Camping Permit displayed on the dash of your vehicle. Camping Permits are designated to one (1) vehicle and cannot be given to any others to display in their vehicles.

CAMPING PERMITS

Permits provided at check-in may be checked periodically. Keep your Camping Permit displayed on the dash of your vehicle.

CAMPSITES AVAILABLE

There are 100 campsites available at the Festival Campgrounds.

CAMPGROUNDS PARKING

There is a designated parking area for the Campground. Upon check-in, staff or volunteers will advise you of this location and/or escort you to the appropriate parking lot area. No camping vehicles are allowed in the Campgrounds, only primitive camping. All camping vehicles are to park in the RV Parking Area.

GUIDELINES

TRASH

Please keep our site clean, place trash in provided receptacles.

PORTABLE TOILETS / RESTROOMS

Portable Toilets are available at the Campgrounds, as well as throughout the Festival grounds. Please leave all supplies for other guests.

PETS

All pets must be on a leash at all times. Owners must clean up pet litter. You will be asked to leave if found not picking up after your pet. Pets are not allowed onto the Festival Grounds. Care should be taken during the events, as some pets become frightened by the sound of balloon burners. As a courtesy to others, please do not walk your dog out of the Campgrounds Area.

BBQ GRILLS

You may have a PROPANE BBQ Grill only-NO charcoal. Grills must be elevated off the ground by at least 2 feet. If you are caught using the grill for other purposes than cooking food, you may be asked to leave as a violation of the rules.
