



Routings through El Reno

1926 - Shepard / Elm / Hoff / Wade / Choctaw / Sunset (then Russell)



1932 - Shepard / Elm / Rock Island / Wade / Choctaw / Sunset

1947 - Rock Island / Wade / Choctaw / Sunset

315 East Wade; El Reno

This historic home was built by Thomas and Minnie Jensen. The two and one-half story, classical revival style residence was finished in the spring of 1909, and was first owned by the son of the 1889 Land Run Pioneer and one of the town founders, Thomas Jensen. The current owners purchased the home in 2015 and enjoy preserving its rich history.



410 East Wade; El Reno

Built in 1910 as an American four square style by local, Mrs. Ida H. Trimble. She furnished rooms and owned M & E Company. This home has been enjoyed by many local families. It was in process of the wrecking ball in 2018. But was totally restored back to its original beauty by a local contractor as his families homestead.

618 South Hoff Avenue; El Reno

Two historic homes in one!! 618 S. Hoff and 614 S. Hoff were combined into one home in 2016. 618 S. Hoff Ave was built in 1903 by local architect, W.H. Riley. 614 S. Hoff was built in 1918 by local mine operator, Joseph Matthews. The combined home retains the historic



elements of both homes while updating mechanical/electrical systems so the home can be enjoyed for another 100 years.



801 South Hoff Avenue: El Reno

This lovely estate was built in 1938 by local doctor, Dr. Malcom E. and Maxine Phelps, which was his family practice, Phelps Clinic located in a Victorian home in the Historical District. Since the home was built, the family residing in this beautiful colonial home is on the 4th in ownership.
