

Riding area allows for motorcycles, ATV's and traditional side-by-sides.

All other vehicles are not allowed, such as: off-road Jeeps, rock crawlers, or street 4-wheeled vehicles.

Extreme hazards exist in riding area.

Drive defensively and use caution.

Vehicles and riders may be subject to inspection upon entering riding area. Access to riding area will be granted to those who satisfactorily complete inspection.



Information and Regulations

1. All riders under the age of 18 must wear a crash helmet which complies with the standards established by 49 C.F.R., Section 571.218.
2. No passengers allowed on/in vehicles unless the vehicle is specifically designed by the manufacturer to carry a passenger in addition to the operator.
3. Riding area hours are from 8 AM to official sunset.
4. Riding area access fee is per rider.
5. No alcoholic beverages allowed in riding area.
6. No pets are allowed in riding area.
7. Use low gear only in campground area and parking lot.
8. Visitors ride at their own risk.
9. Do not cross boundary fence.
10. Vehicle owners are responsible for anyone operating their vehicle.
11. All vehicles must be equipped with the required safety equipment.
12. Any vehicle, which you sit in a seat must have a seatbelt (it must be worn) for each passenger and must have a roll structure sufficient to support the weight of the vehicle.
13. Most trails were designed for vehicles with widths of 72 inches or smaller.

Violators are subject to Prosecution and/or Eviction.
