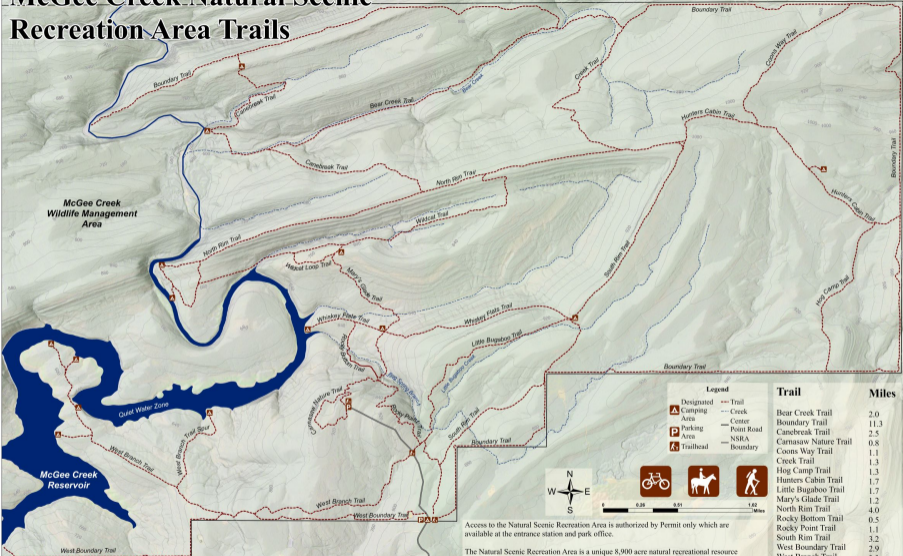


McGee Creek Natural Scenic Recreation Area Trails

Access to the Natural Scenic Recreation Area is authorized by Permit only which are available at the entrance station and park office.

The Natural Scenic Recreation Area is a unique 8,900 acre natural recreational resource authorized by Congress as a feature of the McGee Creek Project. The Natural Scenic Recreation Area was formulated, through a public involvement process, based on four concepts:

1. A quiet water zone.
2. A wilderness-type recreational experience.
3. Non-motorized activities, and
4. Preservation of natural and cultural resources.
