

## Grand Lake State Park

Honey Creek Area  
901 State Park Road  
Grove, OK 74344

Situated on a hillside overlooking Grand Lake O' The Cherokees, the Honey Creek Area is a favorite destination for guests to enjoy the serene atmosphere and quiet, peaceful beauty.

The 30-acre park and surrounding areas are rich in history and cultural diversity. Grand Lake, which surrounds the park, was formed upon completion of the Pensacola Dam in 1940. The nearby town of Grove was surrounded by water after the damming of the lake.

The community of Grove is now a booming metropolis of entertainment venues, restaurants, antique shops, museums and recreational opportunities.

### Park Facilities

**Picnic Area** - Honey Creek has 97 picnic tables, some with grills, plus two group pavilions. Squirrel Hollow Pavilion, located near the park office, has electricity and water and can accommodate up to 75 guests.

Located near Raccoon Ridge, Honey Creek Pavilion has electric and water, and accommodates up to 50 guests.

Pavilions may be reserved up to 11 months in advance.

The Honey Creek Area offers 31 semi-modern RV sites (with water and 30-amp electric) and 20 premium RV sites (with water and 50-amp electric).

There are 9 pull-through RV sites and one that is ADA accessible.

For the tent camper, 33 sites are available with tables and grills.

Five comfort stations are located throughout the park for guest convenience. One RV waste disposal station is available.

### Recreational Opportunities

**Fishing/Boating** - Grand Lake has more than 59,000 surface acres with 1,300 miles of shoreline offering excellent fishing and water-sport activities. Fish species including bass, catfish, crappie, bluegill, and spoonbill are in abundance. A boat ramp, courtesy boat dock, open fishing dock and fish cleaning station are available for visitor use.

**Swimming** - The swimming pool is open to registered campers only, five days a week (weather permitting), from Memorial weekend through mid-August.

Swimming is permitted in Grand Lake, however there are no lifeguards on duty. Please observe all water safety rules.

**Other Amenities** - The park area offers a children's play area with playground equipment and a sand volleyball/badminton area with a net. Balls and racquets are available at the park office to borrow. Personal equipment may also be used.

**Nearby Attractions** - Across the lake from Honey Creek, is Bernice Area of Grand Lake State Park, located one-half-mile east of Bernice, OK on SH 85A. RV and tent camping, picnic sites, swim beach hiking trail and a Nature Center are available for guests at Bernice.


